STEM Program

The Vermont Department of Libraries has received a National Leadership Grant for Libraries from the Institute of Museum and Library Services to fund the Vermont Early Literacy Initiative (VELI) in Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math (STEM), in partnership with the Vermont Center for the Book.

The Cobleigh Public Library is one of 25 Vermont libraries chosen to create STEM programs that include:

- Fun activities on the STEM topic of Light & Sound
- Book giveaways
- Training for librarians
